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4.0 Community Input

Mr. Tommy Brodnax, residing at 15624 Ramsay Lane, addressed the Board regarding concerns with the Tucker Road Sewer Project. The construction on Tucker Road has left no shoulder to allow a vehicle to pull off the side of the road and Mr. Brodnax would like something to be done to restore the shoulder for this purpose. WJCUD's Construction Manager will communicate this need to the construction company, CB Developers. Inc. and will contact Mr. Brodnax to follow up with his request.

Mr. Jason Fayard, resident of 9112 Daisy Vestry Road, addressed the Board regarding two of his duplex rental properties located within the District. Mr. Fayard is requesting two water meters at each duplex to monitor each unit's water usage. Mr. Fayard is also asking that the billing accounts be coded residential to allow the billing to be put into the tenants' names. The Director and the Board Attorney will discuss this matter further and let Mr. Fayard know what legal options are available for this situation at the next board meeting on June 15, 2023.

Mrs. Groves, resident of 15501 Orleans Drive, addressed the Board regarding an ongoing water leak on the corner of her property and Lemoyne Blvd. Mrs. Groves is requesting a board member to view the leak on the street and help resolve this issue. Mrs. Groves sincerely expressed her anguish in dealing with this matter. The Chairman of the Board will go with WJCUD's Construction Manager to view the leak and determine a plan of action to resolve Mrs. Grove's complaint.

6.1 Wastewater Facilities Plan, Phase IV

Mr. Spiers made a motion, seconded by Mr. Westfall, approving Wastewater Facility Improvement Project Pay Application No. 5 to CB Developers, Inc. in the amount of \$215,825.05 as recommended by Machado Patano, contingent upon approval by the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality for currently reimbursable items. Motion passed unanimously.

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6.2 Gravity Sewer Along Old Fort Bayou Road

Mr. David made a motion, seconded by Mr. Spiers, approving authorizing the acceptance of the waiver valuation at 7716 Old Fort Bayou Road under the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, and as later amended, under the procedure described as "waiver valuation." Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. David made a motion, seconded by Mr. Spiers, authorizing entering into a contract with Machado Patano for the engineering design and construct contract administration for the 10-inch SDR 26 PVD Gravity Sewer services generally in accordance with the terms outlined in the attached proposal and for the Director to execute the document for the District.
